Dear colleagues!

On November 21–23, 2023, in Moscow, the 6th International Scientific and Practical Congress "WOUNDS AND WOUND INFECTIONS" with conference "Special Aspects of Anesthesia and Intensive Care in Wound Infections" which will be dedicated to the 50th Anniversary of opening the A. V. Vishnevsky National Medical Research Center of Surgery and to the 10th Anniversary of founding "Surgical Society – Wounds and Wound Infections".

This year, we will focus our close attention on the problems of peacetime and wartime injuries complicated with purulent infection both in children and in adults, on special aspects of anesthesia and intensive care in such cases. This problem deserves attention of various medical specialties – purulent and reconstructive surgeons, traumatologists, anesthesiologists-resuscitators, rehabilitation specialists. We also hope not only to hold an interdisciplinary Congress with broad discussion, but also to develop joint clinical recommendations.

The Organizing Committee draws attention of healthcare organizers (chief physicians of medical institutions, regional chief surgeons, heads of departments and ministries of health) to the upcoming Congress and recommends them to send their specialists to participate in it.

The Congress (with on-line transmission) will be held on November 21–23, 2023, at the A. V. Vishnevsky National Medical Research Center of Surgery by the address: 27 Bolshaya Serpukhovskaya Str. Moscow, Russia.

Conference Agenda:

1. Development of the strategy for providing assistance to victims with complicated trauma in peacetime and wartime – history of the problem.
2. Pathogenesis of the wound process in injuries complicated by surgical infection.
3. Extensive wounds and soft tissue defects of traumatic origin in children and adults.
4. Open fractures of long bones in children and adults.
5. Combat traumas and features of mine-explosive injuries in children and adults.
6. Syndrome of long-term compression in children and adults.
7. Anaerobic non-clostridial infection in closed and open injuries of soft tissues and bones.
8. Early reconstructive skin- and osteoplastic surgeries in traumas complicated by surgical infection.
9. Microbiological characteristics of acute and chronic wounds of soft tissues and bones. The picture of resistance and ways to overcome it.
10. Anesthesia and intensive care in soft tissue and bone injuries complicated by surgical infection in children and adults.
11. Extracorporeal detoxification techniques in soft tissue and bone injuries complicated by surgical infection in children and adults.
12. Hyperbaric oxygenation in extensive defects of soft tissues and bones in children and adults.
13. Management of medical and surgical care for victims with traumas in peacetime and in emergency situations.
14. The role of nursing care in organizing and providing assistance to victims with traumas in peacetime and in emergency situations.

Abstracts, submitted before September 1, 2023, and approved by the Organizing Committee will be published in the conference Proceedings .

Abstracts up to four pages in electronic form (MS WORD, font Times New Roman, size-12, spacing 1.0) should be sent by e-mail: 9057176757@mail.ru. The text should be preceded by author/authors full name, place of work with postal code, contact phone number, e-mail address.

Abstract title – in capital letters.

Full name of author and co-authors - in lower case letters.

Author and co-author affiliation - in lower case letters.

Note: If the co-authors work at different institutions, they are identified by an asterisk symbol with the caption of their affiliations.

Structured abstract specifications: Relevance, Objective, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions.

Note: If the abstract is "Clinical case", their no need to keep to the structured abstract specifications.
